Our Mission

We work collaboratively to ensure safety and survival for people while they are homeless, and to end the crisis of homelessness in our region.

Our Work

We educate, advocate, and organize for safety, housing, and justice. The Coalition on Homelessness unites non-profit service and housing organizations, local government entities, congregations, community groups, and concerned individuals, including people with personal experiences of homelessness. Together, we work to advance reasonable solutions and solid program models; to protect and strengthen the civil rights and dignity of people who are homeless and poor; and to accomplish legislative and public policy victories that promote affordable homes, quality services, and the public good.

We serve as a coordinating force on budget and policy issues that directly affect the lives and futures of people while they are homeless. We organize, mobilize, and educate members, supporters, elected officials, and the public through regular meetings and special projects. Examples of our regular program work:

- We are active in local and state budget and policy processes in order to secure resources and promote immediate, interim, and long-term housing solutions and services for people who are homeless.
- We support homeless students' educational success through education, training, and Project Cool for Back-to-School.
- We encourage a healthy democracy through non-partisan voter registration and education.
- We host regular meetings and trainings for direct service providers and allies.
- We help members of the public understand key issues and speak up effectively to make affordable housing and homelessness priorities through *Homelessness Advocacy 101* workshops.
