

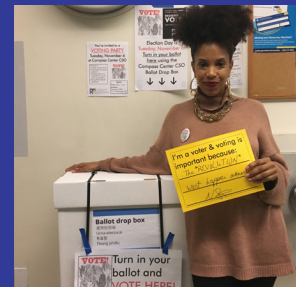

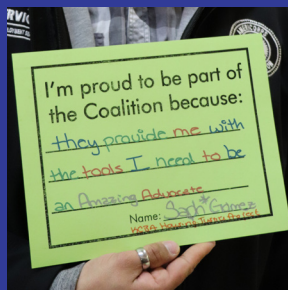

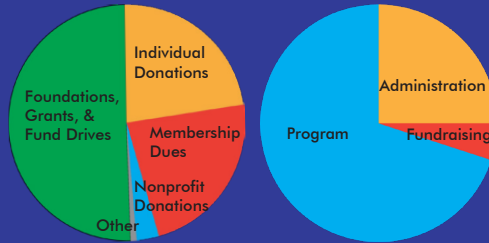
During 2018, more than 1,600 Coalition members and friends spoke up through postcards, online actions, and in-person, calling on elected officials to invest in affordable homes and good services at the state, county, and local level. Your voices, stories, and commitment helped win **\$24.6M/year more for homelessness assistance at the state level, \$165 M for affordable homes in King County, and a modest increase for all Seattle human services agencies.** You also helped pass legislation to make sure every vote counts.
