TOGETHER WE LEAD COVID-19 RAPID RESPONSE

- Facilitate Collective Action. On March 8, as the COVID19 crisis deepened and the legislative session ended, we helped draft a letter to Governor Inslee urging swift action to protect people experiencing homelessness and tenants from COVID-19 and the immense risk it poses to people experiencing homelessness, which was signed by 190 organizations throughout Seattle and King County.
- Develop and share a way to track changes in Homeless Services in our community. Coalition staff collected, organized, and disseminated essential information related to changes in homeless and other social services to support accurate and useful referrals during a time of great upheaval.
- Convene Senior Leaders and front-line staff regularly. The Coalition established a weekly conversation with local agency senior leaders to share information; identify system gaps and problems; engage members in local, state, and federal opportunities to speak up, problem solve, or take action together.

TOGETHER WE CHAMPION SYSTEM CHANGES

- * Raise the voices of our members and community around our shared priorities during city, county, state, and federal budget processes and legislative sessions.
- Activate for legislative change through weekly news, including Action Alerts and advocacy tools, which are designed to keep members up-to-speed about substantive issues and empowering members to contact lawmakers on important decisions

FACILITATE DEEPER COLLABORATION AND LEARNING

- Engage members at our monthly Membership Meetings, a forum for providers and advocates to share information, learn, and make connections, across populations and programs.
- **Educate** members through free trainings to staff at member organizations to advance our shared mission of providing excellent services to people experiencing homelessness.

LEVERAGING PEOPLE POWER & RESOURCES

- Project Cool for Back-to-School supports over a thousand homeless students connected with our member organizations each year with backpacks, school and health supplies.
- Homeless Voter Registration and Education: We register people experiencing homelessness to vote and train volunteers and staff at our member organizations to encourage participation in the democratic process. Central to these non-partisan skills is empowering marginalized groups to know their voting rights
- Homelessness Advocacy 101 Workshops: Our Advocacy 101 workshops turn passion into action by teaching participants how to be a voice for real and positive investments. Join us to help transform these lively sessions into on-line opportunities to learn, connect, and take action in 2021!
